

Proposed Rules of the
“Simposio Latino Americano de Canola – SLAC”

Proposals of the "**Simposio Latino Americano de Canola – SLAC**”:

Article 1. The Symposium aims to create opportunities, organize and present results and discuss proposals for research, development and innovation to increase yield and grain quality, sustainability and also to increase canola growing areas of Latin America;

Article 2. The Symposium will look for the participation and integration of people, institutions and agricultural research companies, professionals that provide technical assistance and rural extension work in other segments of the canola production system, providing a forum for strategic development;

Article 3. The Symposium will be held every two years in different Latin American countries, chosen through submitted application and evaluated in plenary, preferably following a rotation;

Article 4. Two people from each participating country will be chosen during the plenary session of the Symposium in order to join the Organizing Committee of the upcoming event, promoting the participation and the involvement of their respective countries to the development of canola;

Article 5. The site of the Symposium will be available in Portuguese, Spanish and English, and the "Abstract" of the research will be published in English and in Portuguese or Spanish;

Article 6. The annals of the Symposium will be presented, published and distributed at the beginning of the event, prearranged by the Organizing Committee;

Article 7. The Symposium should always be cited in any kind of media by its full name in quotes: "Latin American Symposium Canola - SLAC" or using its abbreviation "SLAC";

Article 8. The Organizing Committee of the Symposium may have other attributions that possibly will contribute to the organization and objectives of the event, proposed as attachments, for example. However, these attachments may be set or adjusted at the discretion of the next Organizing Committee.
